



Making a Difference ... One Life at a Time

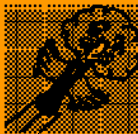
“Jombok Haos” refers to the trees found in abundance at our Adventure Learning Center—and the ability to fly.

Programs

Jombok Haos' programs have been designed to create positive and lasting change in your workplace, organization or team.

Programs focus on identifying and nurturing leadership and team building skills in addition to personal growth and self-confidence. A variety of physical activities and personal and group initiative exercises stimulate active communication, problem solving skills and challenge individuals and teams beyond their perceived boundaries enabling them to realize great achievements. An important factor for learning is the post-activity reflection time, conducted by experienced Khmer facilitators.

In order to fully realize all the learning opportunities Jombok Haos has to offer, 3-4 day programs are best. Shorter programs can also be designed for your special needs.

Talk to our staff about your learning requirements and programs can be tailored for your situation.

Groups

Group sizes from 15 to 25 participants are most effective however larger sizes may also be accommodated where necessary. Participants should be aged from 14 years old and up and be in good health.

Types of groups that have experienced Jombok Haos include NGO staff, School Students, Businesses, Community Volunteers, Community Based Organizations and Disadvantaged Youth.

Facilities

Jombok Haos facilities have been designed using "green" principles. The natural environment has been kept untouched and all facilities are nestled within existing forest.

Onsite accommodation includes:

- Large meeting center
- Two bungalows

Basic sleeping equipment (mattress, mosquito nets) is provided.

Meals

Khmer meals are prepared onsite. Facilities are also available to groups if they wish to cook their own meals.

Cost

Fees for groups are based on group size. Funds received are used for the ongoing operation costs of Jombok Haos, additional site development and to enable local and disadvantaged groups to be able to experience the "Jombok Haos Experience".
